Medical assistants are a vital part of the daily duties of a medical office. They primarily work in outpatient settings, a rapidly growing sector of the health care industry. In smaller offices, they are usually "generalists," handling both clinical and administrative work. Those in larger practices tend to specialize in a particular area such as Cardiology, Pediatrics or Sports Medicine, while others work in hospitals or clinics.

National Career Education (NCE) prepares students for a wide range of administrative and clinical duties.

Administrative duties include:

- updating patient records
- arranging patient lab or hospital visits
- completing insurance forms
- scheduling appointments
- performing medical billing and bookkeeping tasks

Clinical duties vary according to state law, but include:

- taking patients' vital signs
- preparing patients for and assisting the physician during examinations
- collecting and packaging lab specimens
- sterilizing medical instruments
- · educating patients about medications and nutrition
- removing sutures and dressing wounds
